

Global Public Protest Against the Graziani Mausoleum and Fascist Italy's War Crimes in Ethiopia

International public protests are scheduled in major cities throughout the world on Tuesday, February 19, 2013 against the dedication of a mausoleum and a park at Affile in Italy for the Fascist war criminal, Rodolfo Graziani, who was responsible for the three-day massacre of 30,000 Ethiopians in Addis Ababa in February 1937.

FASCIST WAR CRIMES IN ETHIOPIA

The Italian Fascist war crimes against the people of Ethiopia included:

- The massacre of one million Ethiopians using weapons of mass destruction, including the internationally forbidden poison gas.
- The destruction of over 2,000 churches and 525,000 homes.
- Environmental pollution and the killing of over 14 million animals.

As if to add insult to injury, the Italian Government has recently established a mausoleum and a park for the Fascist war criminal, Rodolfo Graziani, at Affile, south of Rome!


Call to Action
